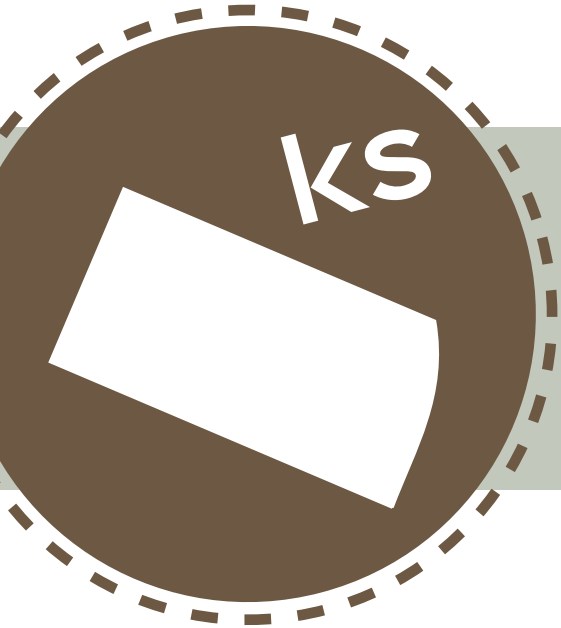


IS JET FUEL BURNING A HOLE IN YOUR STATE BUDGET?

Airlines are **EXEMPT** from the sales tax.
COST: \$13.2 million

MOTOR FUEL vs. JET FUEL (Effective State Fuel Tax Rate)

Car drivers buying an average gallon of gasoline:

\$ **0.24**

Commercial airlines buying a \$3 gallon of jet fuel:

Cost of Sales Tax Break and Number of gallons airlines get a tax break on: Estimate based on 2013 jet fuel prime supplier sales data and jet fuel prices from the Energy Information Administration and commercial airline fuel use data from the Bureau of Transportation Statistics.

Gasoline Tax Rate: Estimates from the American Petroleum Institute (API) based on average price earlier this year.
